#### **UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE SYSTEM MODERNIZATION**

Arizona has deployed a system modernization initiative for the Unemployment Insurance Benefits program, replacing the decades-old system with new technology to improve system functionality and enhance the client experience overall.

#### PARTNERS FOR REENTRY OPPORTUNITIES IN **WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT (PROWD) GRANT**

This initiative is a collaboration between the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL), and the Arizona Department of Economic Security (ADES), which aims to reduce the recidivism among program participants that is caused by having significant barriers to employment. This initiative will aid in improving employment outcomes among program participants, strengthening communities and public safety where grant programs operate.



### **EDUCATION LEVELS** (Age 25 & older)






