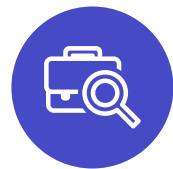

WORKSHARE IL

WorkShare IL is a short-term compensation program providing employers with an alternative to layoffs. 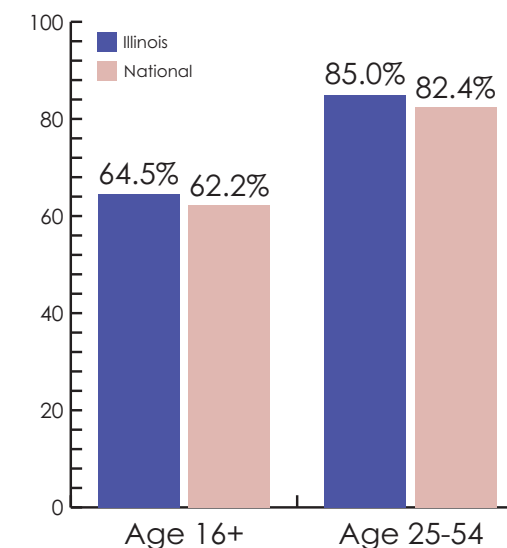

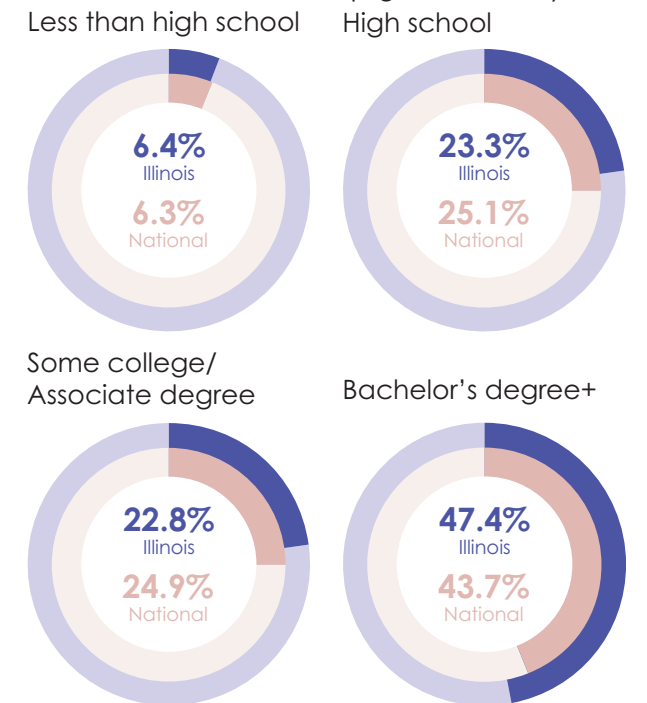

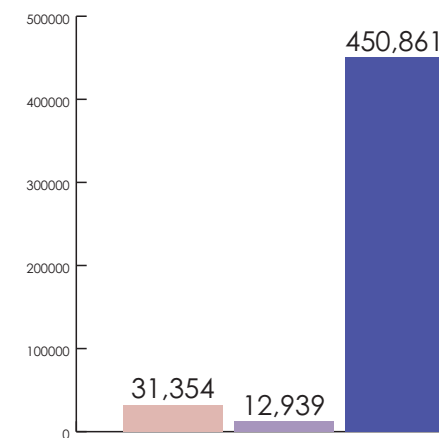
