#### OFFICE OF WORK-BASED LEARNING AND APPRENTICESHIP (OWBLA)

During Program Year 2022, the TAA program focus shifted to outreach. In response, Indiana introduced a gas card incentive to engage past eligible workers. 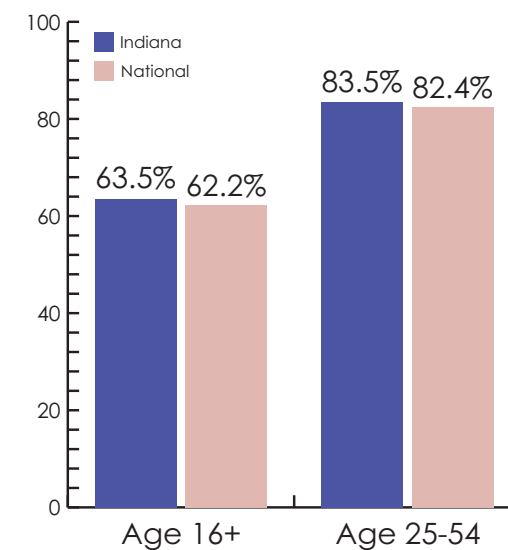

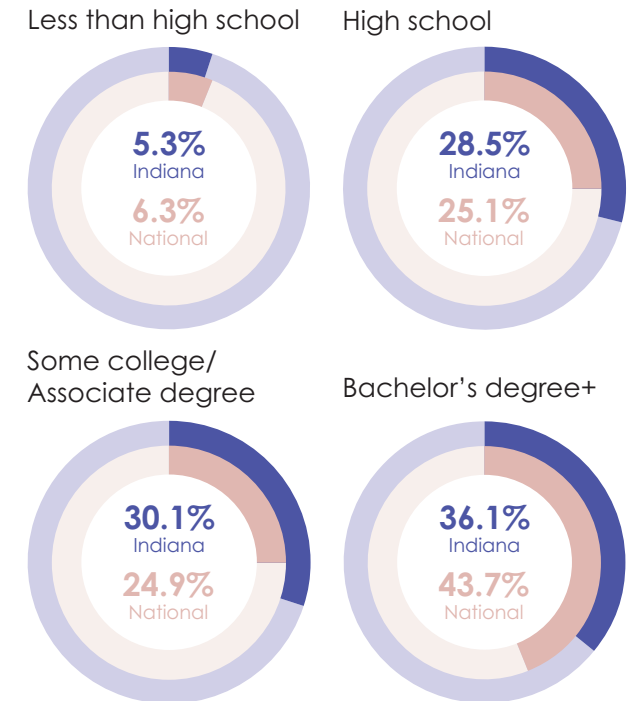

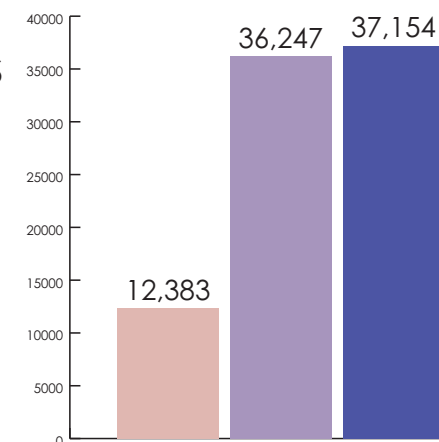

#### UNEMPLOYMENT DATA

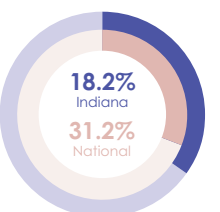
##### Duration Rate (Q4 CY22)
