## REEMPLOYMENT SERVICES AND ELIGIBILITY ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (RESEA)


The RESEA Program procured the 10to8 Self-Scheduling Platform, which allows RESEA participants to schedule their appointments, receive reminders via email and SMS, and reschedule. 10to8 offers calendars for each staff member at the AJC, providing notice of upcoming appointments and advanced notice of the day-to-day traffic.
