UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFITS MODERNIZATION

A modernized UI case management system, which will enhance system availability, access to information, and simplify navigation, is expected Summer 2025. In 2024, enhancements to UI call center infrastructure automated self-service access to claim information and frequently asked auestions. Over 230,000 calls were served via the self-service in 2024.



REHABILITATION SERVICES ADMINISTRATION

A modernized rehabilitation services case management system was launched in July 2025. The new system has been designed to streamline processes and improve service delivery. Additional enhancements include data dashboards that help staff monitor and track activities and timelines for effective case management.




ARIZONA EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATOR APPRENTICESHIP **PATHWAY**

Supporting the Governor's mission to increase high-quality child care, this 2-year apprenticeship provides college coursework, mentorship, and on-the-job experience, resulting in a trained early childhood education workforce and increased compensation for program completers. Central Arizona College administers the program, which includes participation from Glendale and Paradise Valley Community Colleges, Arizona Western College, and Rio Salado College.




