RAPID RESPONSE

The Rapid Response team coordinates with companies when they are facing layoffs and/or closures. Once an organization files its Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (WARN), Rapid Response partners with them to create a customized plan of action, getting employees back to work as soon as possible.

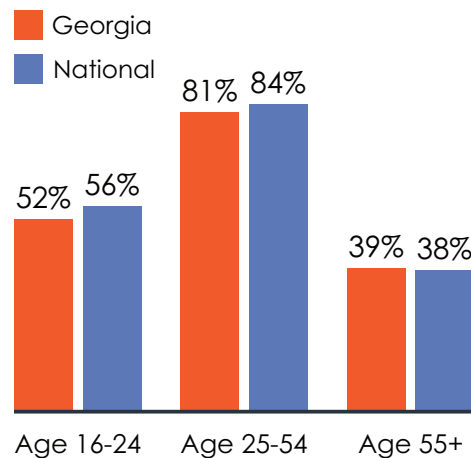

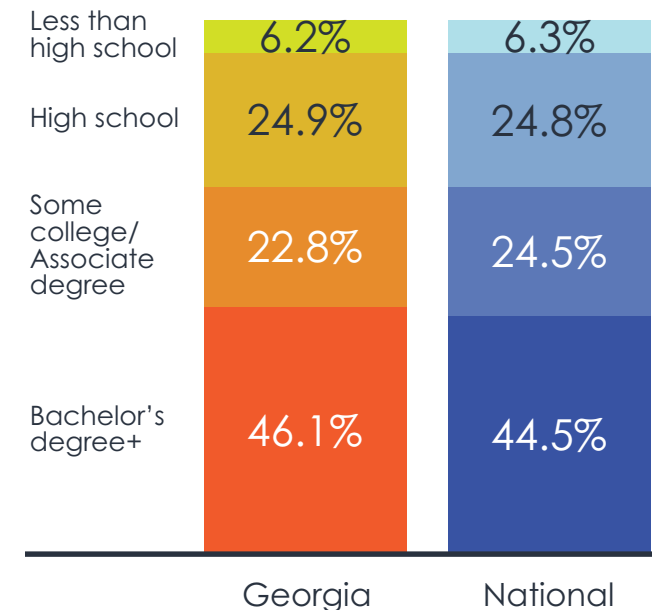

PARTICIPANTS SERVED BY GEORGIA'S WORKFORCE SERVICES



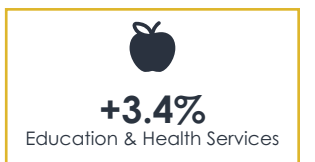

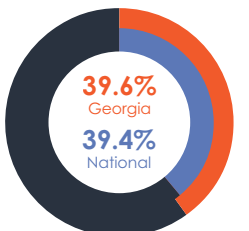
