





CONNECTING JUSTICE-INVOLVED YOUTH TO JOBS

Workforce Services created a strong partnership with Juvenile Justice Youth Services to help connect justice-involved youth with education and jobs after they are released from custody. Approximately 100 youth have been served, and 10 have been placed with on-the-job learning opportunities in the last year.



NAVAJO RESERVATION WIOA YOUTH SERVICES

Workforce Services travels to two remote locations on the Navajo Reservation, partnering with a community center and a local high school to meet with at-risk youth and assist them in accessing WIOA Youth services. Workforce Services has engaged with approximately 100 youth, resulting in 38 WIOA youth enrollments supporting employment and education.



TEACHER REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIPS

Utah is implementing a new registered teacher apprenticeship program, partnering with the Utah State Board of Education. It provides job seekers with high-quality work experience in the role of co-teacher and elevated classroom support beyond the expectations of a traditional education route. 


