The Workforce Data Trust is an information sharing environment ensuring and supporting data discovery and analytics. It provides a scalable alternative to "point-to-point" sharing between agencies and organizations. By securely integrating cross-agency data, the Workforce Data Trust enables deeper program analysis and smarter data driven investments across the Commonwealth.



COMMONWEALTH-WIDE METRICS

As part of our enabling legislation, all programs within the Commonwealth are required to report quarterly on 6 Key Metrics: People Trained, People Placed in Jobs, People Retain in Jobs, Wage Growth, Cost per Participant, and Cost per Program. Some programs can submit alternative metrics of any of these do not apply to them. We are then able to gauge success and improvement over time.




VIRGINIA HAS JOBS INITIATIVE


